This scholarship was created to honor Judge Tracey A. Yokich for her outstanding commitment to the Women Lawyers Association and her unwavering mentorship of women in the legal profession. This scholarship recognizes Judge Yokich's dedication to fostering the professional growth of women lawyers and her tireless efforts to promote diversity, inclusion, and leadership within the legal community, and will serve as a lasting tribute to her legacy of support and guidance, helping future generations of lawyers thrive in their careers.

Judge Yokich's legal career is distinguished by a broad range of public service. She began her legal career as an Assistant Prosecuting Attorney in Macomb County, where she served from 1986 to 1989. She then worked as an Assistant Corporation Counsel for Macomb County from 1989 to 1990 before returning to the Prosecutor's Office in 1997. Her career also includes three terms in the Michigan House of Representatives from 1991 to 1996, where she represented Eastpointe, St. Clair Shores, Lake Township, and Harrison Township. During her time in the legislature, Judge Yokich was an active member of several committees, including Appropriations, Judiciary, Public Health, and Conservation, Environment, and Great Lakes.

In addition to her judicial career, Judge Yokich has a strong record of leadership within the legal community. A longtime member of the Women Lawyers Association, she has been a mentor to many. She is a Michigan State Bar Foundation Fellow and a past president of the Michigan Judges Association. She has also been actively involved with several organizations, including the Selfridge Base Community Council and the Michigan Air Guard Historical Association. Judge Yokich served in the Michigan Air National Guard from 1995 to 2006, further demonstrating her commitment to public service.

Judge Yokich's judicial philosophy is grounded in fairness, integrity, and a commitment to the law. She continues to serve with distinction, drawing on her extensive legal experience, legislative background, and dedication to the citizens of Macomb County.
