Greco Memorial Scholarship is awarded to a second or third year law student who demonstrates a commitment to serve or contribute to the Macomb County legal community, a need for financial assistance, good academic standing (2.5 GPA or better). Special consideration is given to non-traditional law students. This \$3000 scholarship originates from the contributions of Emil E. Cardamone and continues with the generous contributions of Attorneys Title Agency, Greco Title Division and honors the memory of the late Philip F. Greco, Esq.

About Philip F. Greco (1916-1998)

Mr. Greco was a distinguished Macomb County lawyer who founded the title company that

bears his name. Throughout his outstanding life and career, Mr. Greco demonstrated an exemplary commitment to the betterment of the legal and civic communities. He was widely recognized as an expert in real estate law and gratuitously lent his considerable talents to assist attorneys and other practitioners in the real estate industry to resolve complex legal problems. He was an active participant and held leadership positions in numerous professional, charitable and civic organizations. A 1944 graduate of the Detroit College of Law. Mr. Greco is a Past President of the Macomb County Bar Association and one of the founders of the Macomb County Bar Foundation. The awards and honors he received during his lifetime are too numerous to mention in this limited space.

Special consideration is given to non traditional law students. Applications for this scholarship will be accepted at the Macomb County Bar Foundation office by mail, email or in person. This scholarship will be formally announced to the recipient in the Spring.

The application packet must include:

- Completed application
- Candidates most recent law school transcript
- Resume
- Two letters of recommendation
- A personal statement in which the candidate discusses his/her interest in law, reason for applying for scholarship, career goals and any other pertinent information he/she would like the Scholarship Committee to know.
